Memorandum of Understanding

THIS MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (“MoU”) is made on 9th day of February 2015 between the following two entities collectively referred to as “Parties” and each referred to individually as “Party”

Society for Promotion of IT Industry in Punjab (SPITIP), a State Government Society under Administrative Control of Department of Information Technology, Government of Punjab, SCO 193-195, Sector 34-A, Chandigarh which has been nominated as State Implementing Agency (SIA) by Department of Electronics & Information Technology (DeitY), Ministry of Communication & Information Technology, Government of India through its letter No 1(17)/2012-HRD(Vol II) dated 28.2.2014 (Annexure I) for implementation of Scheme for Financial Assistance for Skill Development in Electronics System Design and Manufacturing (ESDM) Sector, acting through Sh. Raj Kamal Chaudhuri, IAS, Vice Chairman, Society for Promotion of IT Industry in Punjab (SPITIP) (herein after referred to as “Society” which expression shall, unless repugnant to the context or meaning thereof, mean and include its successors and permitted assigns) of the FIRST PARTY, and

N. Monga (Retd), Regional Head North (here in after referred to as TSSC which expression shall, unless repugnant to the context or meaning thereof, mean and include its successors and permitted assigns) of the SECOND PARTY.
